Payment, Deposit and Registration

Deposit: \$850 (non-refundable) when place in workshop is confirmed.

Balance due: March 1, 2012

Workshop is limited to 12 participants.

- **Single Occupancy Deluxe:** **\$2,895** (King Bed)
- **Single Occupancy:** **\$2,595** (Queen bed)
- **Double Occupancy Deluxe:** **\$2,450** per person (Shared King Bed)
- **Double Occupancy:** **\$2,350** per person (Twin beds)
- **Triple Occupancy:** **\$2,200** per person (3 Single beds)

Payment Options: We accept Cash, Checks, Money Orders and PayPal. If you use a debit or credit card through PayPal, there will be an additional 4% fee.

To complete your reservation, we require you to sign and return an "Acknowledgement of Risk, Release and Indemnity." This form includes additional terms and conditions of travel, including limitations of obligations to you. This document will be sent to you after you have paid your initial deposit and your place in the workshop has been confirmed. Please read it carefully. The document must be completed, signed and returned to us. Our receipt of the completed and signed form will finalize your reservation.

Cancellation Policies:

- Your deposit is non-refundable. Full payment is required within 60 days of departure. Cancellation from 60 days prior to 45 days prior: cancellation fee is 50% of total trip cost per person. The trip is non-refundable inside of 45 days. If a replacement is secured, travelers will get a refund less \$250.00.
- If you wish to cancel the trip outside of 45 days, a written cancellation request is necessary. No refund for unused portions of the retreat, including but not limited to, missed meals, hotel nights and sightseeing.

Cancellation by Jayme Barrett: Jayme Barrett reserves the right to cancel the trip at any time for any reason, including if there are too few participants, or if the quality of the trip or the safety of travelers is judged by Jayme Barrett in her sole discretion to be compromised. In such cases, a refund of payments received by Jayme Barrett shall constitute full and final settlement. Jayme Barrett is not responsible for any loss incurred on account of non-refundable or non-transferable air tickets. If there is an official warning regarding travel to Morocco, you will receive a full refund.

Travel insurance is highly recommended.



Travel and Flights to Marrakech

You will be responsible for booking your own travel. You can fly into Marrakech Menara Airport and the airline code is RAK. Popular airlines flying into Marrakech are listed below. Participants from the United States will need to fly on September 15th in order to get to Marrakech on September 16th for the start of the retreat.



1. Royal Air Maroc
2. Iberia Airlines. Partners with American Airlines. Change planes in Madrid Barajas. Madrid is the closest European airport.
3. Air France. Partners with Delta Airlines.
4. Easy Jet and Ryan Air are low-cost regional airlines flying from many European cities into Marrakech.

Inexpensive Option - Secure the best airfare or use miles to fly to Europe (Madrid, Milan Malpensa, Paris Charles de Gaulle or London Gatwick). Then book a regional Easy Jet, Ryan Air or Royal Air Maroc flight into Marrakech. Madrid is the closest city to Marrakech and is usually the least expensive flight. Make sure you leave enough time to go through customs and immigration in the European city and you may need to change terminals to get your connecting flight to Marrakech. You will also go through immigration and customs once you arrive in Marrakech.

Travel Documents, Passports, Visas

1. You will need a passport valid through January 2013.
(6 months past your travel dates).
2. United States citizens do not need a Visa to enter Morocco.

Note: The visa and passport requirements to Morocco vary according to the nationality of each traveler and may change at any time for reasons beyond our control. Although we endeavor to provide you with accurate information about these requirements, it remains the responsibility of each traveler to verify that he or she has the appropriate travel documents for his or her nationality. Jayme Barrett is not liable for any expenses or costs arising from any traveler being prohibited from entering Morocco or any other country visited in connection with this trip.



Medical Issues and Travel Insurance

No immunizations are necessary for Morocco. If you have any medical issue that will require professional care while on your trip, you must bring and be responsible for all necessary items and treatments related to your condition. It is strongly recommended that you obtain medical and dental insurance that will cover the cost of any medical or dental assistance you may require during your trip. Before travelling with Jayme Barrett, we strongly recommend you review your personal insurance and health insurance to ensure you have coverage appropriate to meet your needs, and the needs of your family and dependants, in case of any loss of property or illness, injury or death.
